

Logistics

Locations

- The main venue of the conference is located on the ground floor of the Information and Communications Technologies (ICT) building. The talks will take place in ICT 102, poster sessions in ICT 114, 116.
- Conference registration will be open in the foyer of the ICT building on all days except Tuesday. On Tuesday evening, the conference registration will be in the Dining Center.
- Breakfasts, lunches and receptions will be served in the Dining Center (Alberta room).
- The conference banquet will take place in the Ballroom, 3rd floor of the MacEwan center.
- The Institute for Quantum Information Science is on the 3rd floor of Science B.

Meals

Breakfasts and lunches, as well as the banquet on Saturday evening, are included in the registration fees. The breakfast is served Wednesday-Sunday between 7:00 and 8:00, lunch as indicated in the conference schedule. The lunch on Friday will take place at the Heritage Park as a part of the conference outing.
